OPENING YOUR SHUTTERS

Always close the louvres before stacking the shutters open.

Never force the shutters or the louvres open or closed.

Always remove the key when stacking the Aluminium or Security Shutters open. This is to prevent the key from being accidently jammed between 2 shutters.

When stacking your Plantation Shutters® open, be mindful not to stack them all together and then move them to the desired position. We recommend starting from the position you would like the shutters moved to, and begin by stacking them two by two until the whole set is gathered together.

TRACK MAINTENANCE

Keep the tracks clean by regularly vacuuming inside the track.

RAIN DAMAGE

Be mindful of open windows behind shutters when it rains, as rain may cause damage to Timber Shutters.

SHUTTER MAINTENANCE

Avoid cleaning products such as Mr Min or any wood spray or oil on Timber Shutters.

Use a dust cloth to dust and clean your shutters.

Do not use any detergents to clean any marks on shutters, only use a damp cloth for cleaning stubborn marks.

Keep dogs away from timber louvres.

If a louvre breaks, please contact Plantation Shutters,[®] as it is easy for us to repair!
